AUDITIONING TIPS

MUSIC:

Choose a short, well known song that is appropriate for the part.

Please practice BEFORE you audition.

Please MEMORIZE your music! Holding notes or music is not allowed.

Add one or two relevant gestures to your song.

If using a track, please bring it with you.

APPEARANCE:

Wear nice clothing, suitable for a "dressy" occasion.

Do not wear something you are uncomfortable in.

If you are coming from or going to another activity, please change for the audition.

Pull your hair back off your face so we can see your eyes. You do not need to pull it entirely back, but we need to see your facial expressions.

PAPERWORK:

Bring a photo. The picture does not have to be an expensive, professional shot. A simple school picture or even a snap shot of your head and shoulders is fine.

Bring a resume. Even someone with next to no experience can have a resume! You should include your height, grade in school and this acting camp of course!!

OTHER HELPFUL HINTS:

Bring your calendar! We ask for conflicts, and need you to confirm your availability when auditioning.

Write Legibly!!! If we cannot read your application, we cannot contact you.

Always introduce yourself when you enter the room. For example:

"Hi! My name is _____. I will be singing _____"
